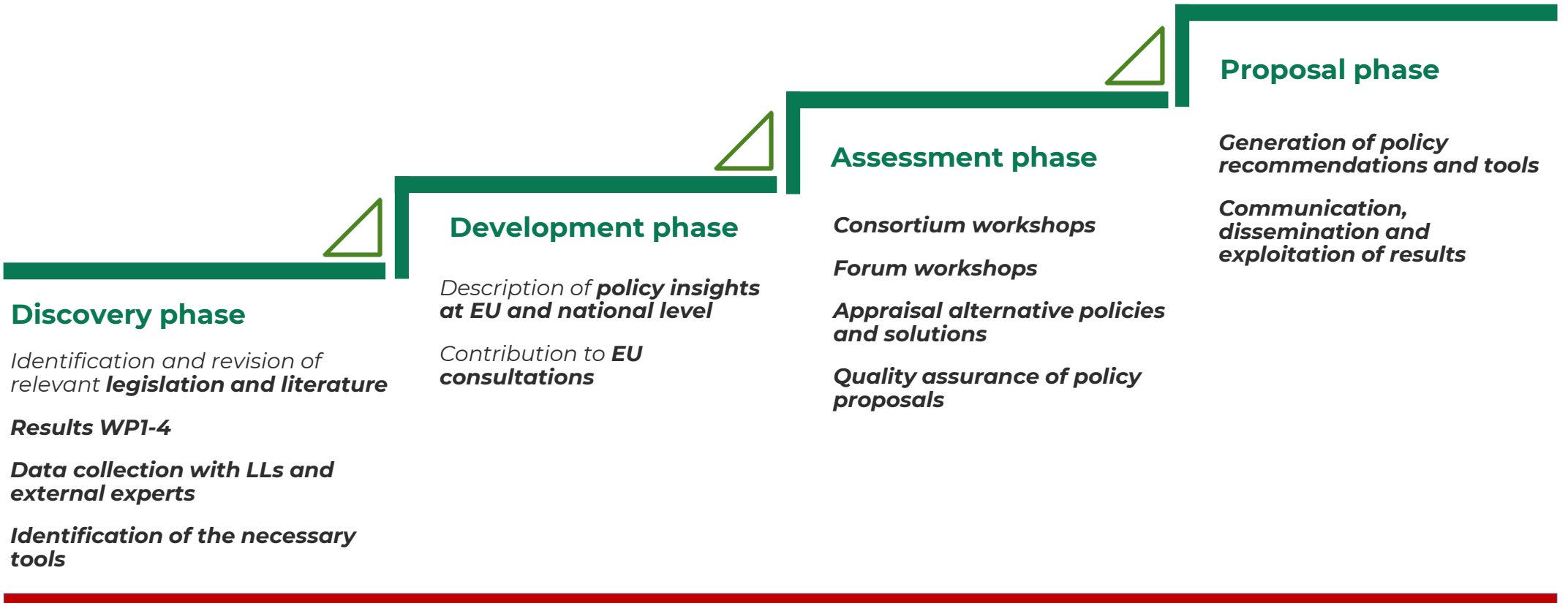

It has been created as part of task 5.1, which focuses on developing recommendations for including women in policies that support the agricultural transition and the future of rural areas at both EU and national levels.

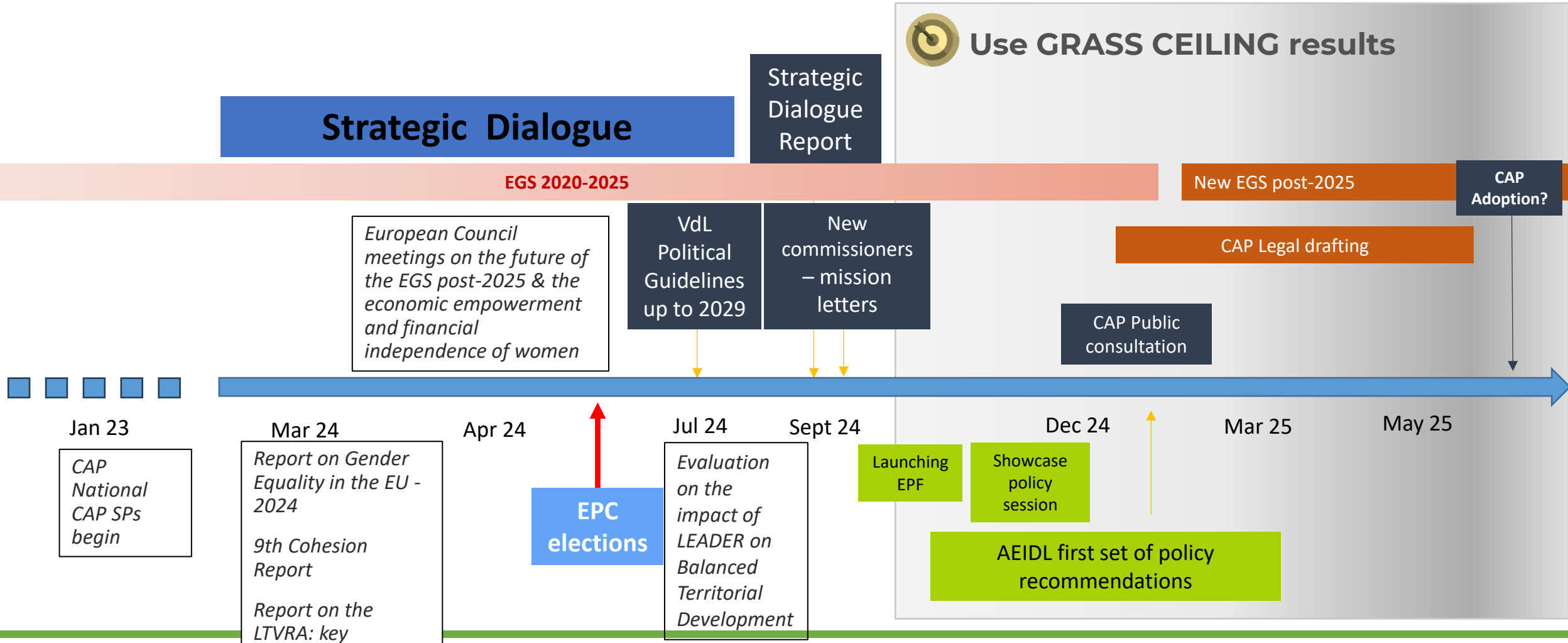
